# Carson Valley Arts Council Promotes Community and Family Arts

CVAC sponsors the Record Courier's Halloween Coloring Contest (now in its 16th year) for children and Gingerbread House contest which transferred to the Historical Society. CVAC's first Art Scavenger Hunt was held in July 2020. In aorder to keep interest in the arts alive during the pandemic and generate a family friendly activity for the arts during the Covid 19 Pandemic, the Carson Valley Arts Council organized an Art Scavenger Hunt. The Hunt in 2020 and 2021 sent participants on a quest through Douglas County. CVAC's Art Scavenger Hunt featured eight places where art pieces were located.

"May the Fourth be With YOU!" CVAC partnered with the Town of Minden for two years to bring a family fun, Star Wars theme day to the community with costume contests, Jedi training, arts and more.

## **CVAC Youth Arts Outreach**

CVAC sponsored the Missoula Children's Theatre for local Douglas county elementary schools.



Missoula Children's Theater presented week-long workshops, auditions, practices and performances at

Scarselli, Jack's Valley, Minden, CC Meneley and Pinion Hills Elementary. Schools.

Over the past five years, CVAC donated more than \$23,000 to support Missoula Children's Theatre, artist workshops, and assemblies in elementary schools.

CVAC sponsored a new 4 day, Youth Arts Camp at C.C. Meneley Elementary School in June 2019. Pandemic changes postponed other art camps.



### **CVAC Arts Mini-Grants**

In 2018 the Carson Valley Arts Council began its Arts Mini-grant program for Douglas County teachers and schools. CVAC has provided funding to Gardnerville, Jack's Valley and Scarselli Elementary Schools for new murals and funds for Scarselli, Jack's Valley and Pinon Hills Elementary Schools for the Missoula Children's Theatre, plus arts curriculum, and Douglas High School Music Department and Pau Wa Lu Middle school received funding for music equipment and art projects.

Thanks to our many supporters and sponsors, Carson Valley Arts Council has given more than \$7,300 in minigrants to support arts education in Douglas County.
