CVAC again this year collaborated with TOCCATA-Tahoe Orchestra and Choir to bring three classical concerts to Gardnerville in 2018-2019.

CVAC Partners with UNR Extension


Carson Valley Arts Council helped support 6 artists who painted community bee boxes.




2019-20 CVAC Income & Expenses
