Marley's Ghost Comes to Carson Valley April 5

The Carson Valley Arts Council will present Marley's Ghost in concert on April 5, 2019 at the CVIC Hall in Minden. As the L.A. Weekly aptly put it, "This West Coast group deftly dashes across decades of American music to create a sound that's steeped in tradition but never bogged down by traditionalism." Get your tickets early for this awesome band.

The band celebrates its 30th anniversary with the release of *The Woodstock Sessions*, helmed by Grammy-winning producer Larry Campbell. Known for his artful work with Bob Dylan, Levon Helm, and countless others, Campbell guides the Ghost's dig into its garden of deep roots to uncover a host of hidden gems. Featuring its trademark multi-part harmonies and multi-instrumental skills, the band's 11th album is a resonant road trip through America's past set firmly in the present.

An eclectic aggregation composed of singer/multi-instrumentalists Dan Wheetman, Jon Wilcox, Mike Phelan, Ed Littlefield Jr., Jerry Fletcher, and Bob Nichols – the band can sing and play anything with spot-on feel, from roots to rock, blues to bluegrass, gospel to stone country, which is what they've been doing – to the ongoing delight of a fervent cult that includes many of their fellow musicians – throughout their first quarter century as a working unit. Their trademark multi-part harmonies never cease to captivate, whether on record or in live performance.

Passion of St. Mathew

Sunday, April 14 – 4PM – Trinity Luthern Church, Gardnerville

The first performance of the St. Matthew Passion was given at the Leipzig Thomaskirche, on Good Friday of 1727. But Bach greatly revised his greatest, most complex liturgical work in 1736, and the Toccata Presentations are based on that version. The St Mathew Passion, in this form, was his last major composition for the Leipzig congregations.

The St. Matthew Passion was written for two separate Choirs, accompanied by two small Orchestras. In most Arias, only one Orchestra provides accompaniment. The Choirs are sometime separated, but more often sing in unison or antiphony - moving the story forwards, and also providing commentary on the events. At different times, the Choruses appear as an unruly mob, or quiet witnesses, or actual participants in the story.

Vocal Soloists for this presentation will include: Daniel Paulson as the Evangelist; Stuart Duke as Jesus; Michael Lloyd as Peter; Richard Haines as Judas; Brad Perry as Pilate; and Chris Nelson as the Priest. Joy Strotz, Becky Earl, Anne Davidson, and Kate Kalthoff will also perform, in various other roles.

The Douglas County performance is April 14 at Trinity Lutheran Church, Gardnerville. Tickets are \$30 for adults (\$40 preferred seating); \$25 for seniors; free for youth under 23 (\$15 preferred seating). 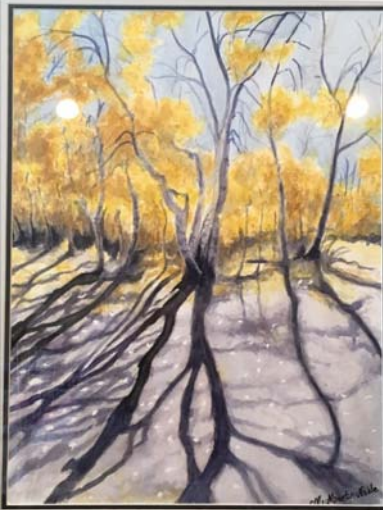

HISTORICAL MARKERS

- 117: Kingsbury Grade/Dagget Pass**
Shortened the trail to California; became path of Pony Express.
- 118: Luther Canyon**
Canyon used by horse thieves who stole from emigrants.
- 120: Walley's Hot Springs**
Regular stage stop on Emigrant Trail.
- 121: Mottsville**
Early community and first cemetery in area.
- 122: Sheridan**
Early community and store in 1850s.
- 123: Cradlebaugh Bridge**
Built in 1861 by William Cradlebaugh. It was the first bridge across the Carson River.
- 124: Boyd Toll Road**
Toll road connected Genoa to mountain mines.
- 125: Twelve Mile House**
1860 waystation where Boyd and Cradlebaugh toll roads converge.
- 129: Gardnerville**
Established in 1897 when Lawrence Gilman moved the Kent house/Gardnerville hotel to this site, the homestead of John M. Gardner.
- 130: Minden**
Established in 1906 by H. F. Dangberg; site of V & T Railway depot.
- 131: Dresserville**
Forty acres given to Washoe Tribe in 1917 by state senator and rancher, William F. Dressler.
