Janice has had a love for Art Glass for many years. Touring glass blowing facilities in Germany and Switzerland fueled her infatuation with the medium. In 2003 she participated in a glass fusing class in Reno, not realizing she would become totally obsessed with the idea of creating her own designs.

Reta Hanks

One of Reta's favorite pass times is painting, and her favorite medium is watercolor. Watercolor takes on a life of its own and tends to create a unique result on paper. I like painting landscapes and I also like to dream up whimsical colorful abstracts that may include pen and ink. I hope to spark the viewer's imagination. I also enjoy using oils and a palette knife, no brushes, to create small brightly colored paintings. This technique produces lots of interesting texture.


