# Red Dirt Ruckus Coming in January! Kicking off the New Year!

The Carson Valley Arts Council is pleased to present an evening with Red Dirt Ruckus. Red Dirt Ruckus will perform at the CVIC Hall, 1602 Esmeralda in Minden, at 7 p.m. Friday, January 31, 2025.

From deep in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada comes a toe-tapping, hip shakin' sound that can't be pinned down. With a healthy dose of bluegrass, a sprinkle of reggae and a big-ole spoonful of funk, Red Dirt Ruckus has been leaving crowds smiling with their own brand of "foothill rudegrass" for almost a decade. This five-piece band rides a high-energy blend of original music by songwriters Doug "Not Josh" Neal (lead vocals/guitar/mandolin) and Dan "Mad Monk" Abbott (lead vocals/bass). Brought to life with the fiddle skills of Lisa Bond (fiddle/back-up vocals), spiced up by Jared Collins on sousaphone and trumpet, and held down by Rob Keedy on drums and percussion.

Tickets are \$22 members, \$25 general audience, and kids under 18 are free with a paid adult ticket. # MINI- GRANTS to Local Music & Art Teachers



To benefit this year, your IRA Qualified Charitable Deduction needs to be made before December 31. Call your financial advisor or IRA administrator for more details on how to make the IRA charitable deduction work for you.


