Dave Stamey is featured in CVAC 20th Anniversary Concert Series

The Carson Valley Arts Council is pleased to present an evening with Dave Stamey. Dave Stamey will perform at the CVIC Hall, 1602 Esmeralda in Minden, at 7 p.m. Friday, November 15, 2024. This is the second concert in our 2024-2025 Concert Series.

Dave Stamey has been a cowboy, a mule packer, a dude wrangler, and is now one of the most celebrated Western entertainers working today. Eight-time Entertainer of the Year, seven-time Male Performer of the Year and five-times Songwriter of the Year by the Western Music Association, and received the Will Rogers Award from the Academy of Western Artists. In November of 2016 Dave was inducted into the Western Music Hall of Fame.

Tickets are \$22 members, \$27 general audience, and kids under 18 are free with a paid adult ticket. 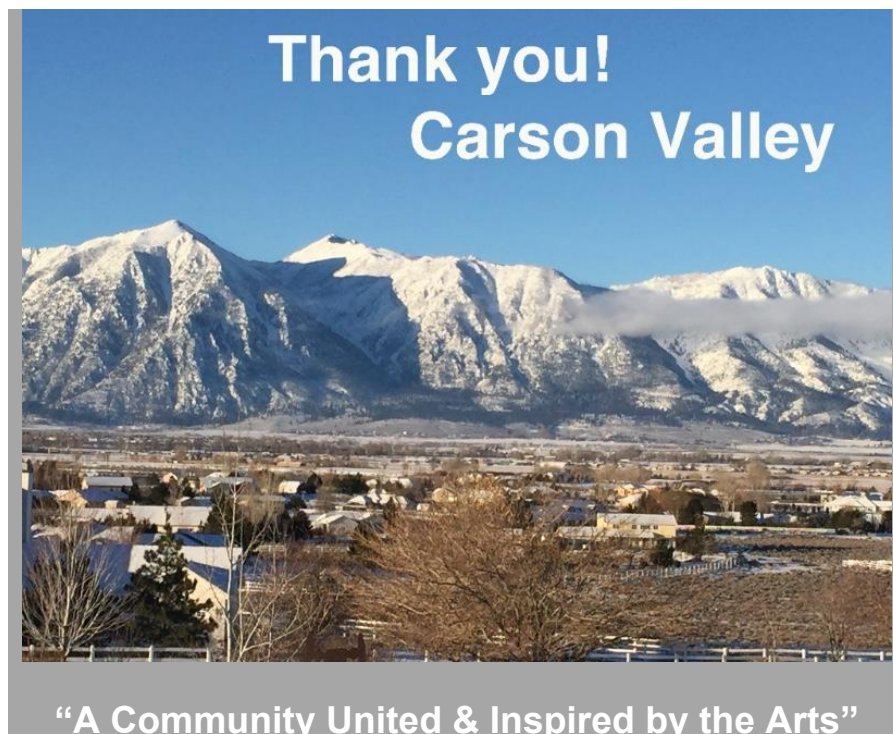
