## Copeland Gallery REOPENS with Artist Veryal Zimmerman



The next art exhibit at the Carson Valley Arts Council's Copeland Gallery features artist Veryal Zimmerman of Dayton, Nevada. The show runs November 2 through December 30, 2020. CVAC will be hosting an artist's reception on Saturday, November 7, from 1 pm to 3 pm. Come and meet Veryal while previewing her amazing art. Masks will be required at the reception. Veryal is an artist who works primarily in oils and pastels. She has exhibited in many group and solo exhibits at numerous galleries in Beacon, Highland, Kingston, Poughkeepsie, NYC, all of New York State; Connecticut; Nevada; Washington, DC; and Olsztyn, Poland.

Her works can be found in numerous private collections in Florida, Missouri, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Puerto Rico, Tennessee, Texas, and London, England. Veryal obtained her BFA in Painting at SUNY New Paltz, New York and prior to that she attended UNC Chapel Hill in North Carolina.

After graduation she opened a Gallery in Beacon, NY to give emerging artists an opportunity to develop their artistic resumes along with professional assistance involving matting and framing details. Nine years later Veryal opened Gallery 475 to promote her own art.

Having recently moved to Nevada Veryal is challenged by the intense colors and shapes of the environment of the west and is hoping the new look will help promote her artistic career.
